Standard Points Structure & Rules

Point system will be disclosed prior to the first race. Copies available at sign-in booth, upon request. There may be modifications to the points structure for Non Standard format events.

1. Point Rules

- 1.1. Points follow the driver's registered car number.
- 1.2. Drivers may time in only one (1) kart number in their class and run that number kart for the entire event.
- 1.3. Substitute Drivers are Allowed.
 - 1.3.1. Substitute drivers are permitted for only two (2) scheduled point races. The Substitute driver must run the karts number that they are substituting for to receive points. If a driver has missed one (1) race, then that driver shall not be allowed a substitute.
 - 1.3.2. Substitute drivers must be declared prior to qualifying.
 - 1.3.3. If a sub is required after qualifying has been completed, the sub must be approved by the Director of Competition and the scorers must be notified. A substitute at any point counts as a one (1) full substitute.
 - 1.3.4. Any sub after qualifying has been completed will constitute a driver change and must start in the back of their next qualified event.
 - 1.3.5. If the original driver replaces a substitute driver they must start in the back of the next qualified event.
 - 1.3.6. Drivers may not substitute for lower classes.
- 1.4. With promoter approval prior to season start, any two drivers may share a kart for a season and earn a single point position (either driver can qualify and earn position for kart)

2. Rookie of the Year

- 2.1.1. Rookie of the year will be determined by the highest point earner with eligible rookie status.
- 2.1.2. A driver is not eligible for rookie status, if he or she has previously attempted 3 races or more during the previous seasons in the class applying for.

3. Standard Points Structure

- 3.1. Show Up Points
 - 3.1.1. Competitors signing in will receive 20 points if they do not start the A-main.
- 3.2. Qualifying Points
 - 3.2.1. Quick time will award 20 points with 2 points less for each position that follows.
1st - 20, 2nd - 18, 3rd - 16, etc
- 3.3. Heat Race(s)
 - 3.3.1. Winner will receive 25 points with 2 points less for each position that follows.
1st - 25, 2nd - 23, 3rd - 21, and so on until 8th
 - 3.3.2. In Heats with over 8 entries, finishers 8th or worse will receive 11 points.
- 3.4. A-Main
 - 3.4.1. Winner will receive 55 points with 2nd receiving 3 points less, each position that follows will receive 2 points less.
1st - 55, 2nd - 52, 3rd - 50, 4th - 48, and so on until 16th
 - 3.4.2. In A-Mains with over 16 cars, finishers 16th or worse will receive 24 points
- 3.5. All Cars not starting the A-Main will receive 20 points, This is the same as show up points and would be in addition to Qualifying and heat points if the car registered any laps in those races.
